Available Services and Resources for Educators

Books in a Box

This service loans a collection of books to preschools, daycares, and schools within our service district. These items check out for 8 weeks.

Assignment Alert

Library staff will gather appropriate materials to support your classroom assignment. Advance notice is required.

Brighton... Naturally Resource Boxes

Nature-based resource boxes filled with books, audio-visual materials, learning toys and activities on a variety of topics related to the natural world.

Parent-Teacher Collection

These materials offer a wide variety of resources on a child's growth and development and a vast array of parenting and education topics for children of all ages.

Special Needs Collection

This collection aids the person with visual and hearing impairments, cognitive challenges, motor, speech or language delays, and emotional and behavioral issues. Parents, caregivers, and teachers of special needs students will find these resources very helpful.

Therapeutic Toy Collection

These hands-on toys and activities encourage creativity, conversation, and active play. Some help build fine motor skills, others offer tactile stimulation. Speech and therapy cards are excellent for cognitive, speech, or emotional impairments. Our story kits help children with comprehension.
