The theme is Your Favorite Fandom.

From comic books to TV series, pick whatever you are a HUGE fan of and let it inspire your drawing.

Submissions are limited to 1 entry per person and must be no larger than 9" X 12". All black and white or color drawing formats, including prints of artwork, are acceptable. Artwork must have been created in 2017 and not have been used for commercial purposes. Entries will be judged on originality, creativity, and how well the artwork reflects the contest theme. If you wish to protect your work against damage, please submit art in protective covering. If using charcoal or pastel, please spray with protective coating to prevent smudging.

Winners and honorable mentions will be selected from 3 age groups: Kids ages 5-12, Teens ages 13-17, and Adults ages 18 and up. First place and honorable mention winners will be notified by July 31 and announced to the public at 7:45pm on Thursday, August 3 during LibCon 2017. Submitted drawings will be available for pick up from your library August 4 - August 12. All drawings not picked up by August 12 will be discarded.
